1.	What is CMAT?	The Common Management Admission Test (CMAT) is a National Level Entrance Examination for admission to management programmes in the country. This Test facilitates AICTE Affiliated/ Participating Institutions to select suitable graduate candidates for admission to the Management Courses in their Institutions.
		The CMAT score is accepted by all AICTE - Affiliated Institutions / University Departments / Constituent Colleges / Affiliated Colleges.
2.	What is the responsibility of NTA for CMAT?	The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online application, conduct of entrance test, declaration of results and providing Scores to AICTE.
3.	Will the test centres be as mentioned in the Information Bulletin?	No. Only the Test Cities are mentioned in the Information Bulletin.
4.	Will the test centre choosen during the application will be allotted?	As far as possible the candidate will be given the chosen city for test, However, a different city may be allotted due to administrative reasons.
5.	Can a centre be allotted by the NTA manually?	No.
6.	Is there any Negative Marking in the CMAT?	Yes, there is Negative Marking in CMAT.
7.	Is there any helpline for CMAT Examination for the aspirants?	Yes. Details are available on NTA website-https://exams.nta.ac.in/CMAT/, Helpline No 011-40759000 (Operational 09:30 AM to 06:00 PM during working days).
8.	Whether the examination will be offline or online?	It is a Computer Based Test.
9.	What is the medium of Question paper?	The medium of question paper is English only.
10.	How will a candidate select a city of their choice for examination?	The candidate should select 4 cities of their choice in order of preference for examination of CMAT 2025 from the drop-down box where all cities where exam is going to be conducted would be reflected.
11.	What would be the validity of CMAT 2025 result?	The validity of the result of CMAT 2025 shall be only for the current academic session i.e. 2025-26 for admission into management programmes in institutes which are affiliated to AICTE.

17.	What are the enclosures that should be attached with the confirmation page to be sent to NTA?	Candidates are not require document(s) including Corpost/ Fax/ By Hand.			•





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19.	Does NTA verify the documents and what is the role of NTA in counselling? What do the candidates need to bring to the exam center?	NTA does not verify the information provided by the candidates during online registration and hence candidature will be purely provisional subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as per AICTE. NTA has no role in counseling and admissions. Candidates are advised to carry only the following with them into the Examination venue:
		 a) Admit Card along with Self Declaration (Undertaking) downloaded from the NTA Website (a clear printout on A4 size paper) duly filled in. b) A simple transparent Ball Point Pen. c) Additional photograph, to be pasted on Attendance Sheet d) Personal transparent water bottle. e) ID Proof f) Sugar tablets/fruits (like banana/apple/orange) in case the candidate is diabetic.
20.	Requirement for photograph?	 Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. Photograph should cover 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly. Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable. Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected. Candidates may please note that if it is found that photograph uploaded is fabricated i.e. deshaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means and the candidate wouldbe dealt with accordingly. Application without photograph shall be rejected. The photograph need not be attested. Candidates are advised to take 6 to 8 passport size colored photographs with white background.





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21.	Will any candidate be able to leave early if he finishes the test before the allocated test time?	No, candidate will not be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before the test concludes.
22.	When is the CMAT-2025 going to be held?	CMAT 2025 exam will be held on 25th January, 2025.
23.	When Candidates can download Admit Cards for CMAT-2025?	To be announced later through website. Candidates have to download the Admit Card from the website https://exams.nta.ac.in/CMAT/ only.Admit cards will not be sent to candidates.
24.	If a candidate is unable to download the Admit Card, whom should he/she contact?	In case of any difficulty, mail us on cmat@nta.ac.in or can call on helpline numbers mentioned in Information Bulletin.
25.	Can a candidate change the examination centre after allotment of Admit Card?	Examination Centre cannot be changed.
26.	If mistakenly during filling up of the form, wrong particulars are filled in the online form, how will it be corrected?	When the correction window is opened by NTA the correction in particulars of Application Form can be made online and submitted. Once submission is done after correction no further correction will be allowed.
27.	Can anyone cancel the application submitted for CMAT?	Online Application form submitted successfully cannot be cancelled/withdrawn.
28.	What is the minimum eligibility criteria/qualification for appearing in CMAT 2025?	 The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline. Candidates appearing for the final year of Bachelor's Degree, whose result will be declared before commencement of admission for academic year 2025-26, can also apply for CMAT-2025. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
29.	What is the age limit/relaxation criteria for the candidates appearing in CMAT?	There is no age limit for CMAT-2025.





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30.	How can one remit fee for CMAT 2025?	Pay fee using SBI Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking/UPI and keep proof of fee paid. In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of fee then the transaction is cancelled, and amount will be refunded to the candidate's account. However, the candidate has to make another transaction, in case the Confirmation Page is not generated.
31.	If any candidate faces any problemin remittance of fee due to failed transaction, what can he/she do?	If the payment status of online transaction (by credit/debit card) is not communicated by payment gateway in real time then fee payment is not completed and the candidate will not be able to download the Confirmation page. In this case, the candidate is required to pay fee again through online mode and download the Confirmation page. The amount due to failed transaction of credit/debit card will be refunded back after reconciliation with the bank.
32.	If a candidate for any reason has not appeared in the examination, is there any provision for fee refund?	No. Once the online application form is submitted successfully by the candidate, it cannot be withdrawn and no refund will be made.
33.	Is Aadhaar mandatory for CMAT?	Yes. The Aadhaar number is only one of the types of identification andis not mandatory. Candidates may also enter Passport number, Ration Card number, Bank Account number or any other valid Government identity number.
