- Issuance of this Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of the fulfilment of eligibility of the candidate, which shall be further be scrutinized at subsequent stages of the process held at EPFO. Mere possession of this Admit Card shall not entitle the candidate to make any claim to the post.
- Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein. Any tampering in the particulars, photograph and signature in this Admit Card shall be considered as Unfair Means (UFM) practice and the same will be dealt with as per Law.
- Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
- Admit Card will not be sent by post/mail.
