1.	What is Joint Integrated Programme in Management Test (JIPMAT)- 2025?	JIPMAT-2025 is Joint Integrated Programme in Management Test for admission to 5 years Integrated Programme in Management at IIM Bodh Gaya and IIM Jammu.
2.	What is the responsibility of NTA for JIPMAT- 2025?	The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting Online Application, conduct of entrance test, declaration of result and providing scores to IIM Bodh Gaya and IIM Jammu.
3.	What is the date for applying online for JIPMAT-2025?	The online link to apply online for JIPMAT-2025 is available between 11.02.2025 and 10.03.2025 at <u>https://exams.nta.ac.in/JIPMAT/</u>
4.	What is the last date of submission of application fee?	Candidates can pay the application fee only online upto 11.03.2025 (11.50 p.m.)
5.	Schedule for correction in the Particulars in Online Application Form?	The correction window will be open from 13.03.2025-15.03.2025 where candidate can correct certain details in his/her Application Form.
6.	Intimation of Cities of exam centres?	To be announced later on website at <u>https://exams.nta.ac.in/JIPMAT/</u>
7.	What is the date of the exam?	The exam will be conducted on 26.04.2025
8.	What are the exam timings?	The exam will be held from 3.00 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. (2.30 hours)
9.	What is the mode of conducting the test?	The test will be conducted in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode.

OCI/PIO	As per Judgement dated Feb 3, 2023, passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP (C) 891/2021, the OCI candidates who have registered for OCI/PIO before 4/Mar/2021 will be considered for the seats allocated to the Indian nationals (under General category only). The candidates must pay the application fee by choosing the appropriate option while filling in the application form.

28.	What is the latest time for entry into the exam centre	Candidate is required to reach Centre as per the Reporting/Entry time at Centre given in the Admit Card to avoid any crowding at the Centre at the time of entry and to maintain social distancing.		
29.	Can I leave the test hall, if I complete the test before time?	No. You can't leave the test hall until the test concludes and the invigilator allows you to go.		
30.	What are the items which are permitted inside the test hall?	 You are permitted to carry, only the following items to the test centre: Admit Card along with Self Declaration (Undertaking) downloaded from the NTA Website (a clear printout on A4 size paper) duly filled in. A simple transparent Ball Point Pen. Additional photograph, to be pasted on Attendance Sheet Personal transparent water bottle. ID Proof Sugar tablets/fruits (like banana/apple/orange) in case the candidate is diabetic. 		
31.	Should I carry some blank sheets to the exam centre for doing rough work?	No. You will be provided rough sheet at the exam centre for doing rough work.		
32.	Should I carry a calculator?	No.		
33.	Will the question paper be bi-lingual?	No, the question Paper will be in English only.		
34.	Do I have to surrender the admit card to the invigilator at the exam centre?	No. You are not required to hand over your admit card to the invigilator after the conclusion of the exam.

37.	What is Marking Scheme?	 Each question carries 04 (four) marks. For each correct response, candidate will get 04 (four) marks. One (01) mark will be deducted for a wrong answer. Un-answered/un-attempted will be given no marks. To answer a question, the candidate needs to choose one option as correct option. However, after the process of Challenges of the Answer Key, in case there are multiple correct options or change in key, only those candidates who have attempted it correctly as per the revised Answer key will be awarded marks. In case a Question is dropped due to some technical error, full marks shall be given to all the candidates irrespective of the fact who have attempted it or not.
