**Subject: Release of the Admit Card for the National Common Entrance Test [NCET 2025] – Reg.**

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will conduct the **National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2025** for admission to the **4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)** in selected Central/State Universities/Institutions including IITs, NITs, RIEs, and Government Colleges for the **Academic Session 2025–26** on **29 April 2025 / 09 वैशाख 1947 (Tuesday)**.

The City Intimation Slip for the above-mentioned examination has already been hosted on the website <https://exams.nta.ac.in/NCET/> on **21 April 2025**. Admit Cards for the NCET 2025 examination are now being released today, i.e., **25 April 2025 / 05 वैशाख 1947**.

Candidates are advised to download their respective Admit Cards from <https://exams.nta.ac.in/NCET/> using their **Application Number and Date of Birth**. They must read the instructions contained in the Admit Card carefully.

This Admit Card is being issued provisionally, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the Information Bulletin. Issuance of the Admit Card does not imply final acceptance of eligibility, which will be verified at subsequent stages of the admission process. Candidates must not mutilate the Admit Card or make any changes to the entries made therein.

*Any alteration or tampering with the details, photograph, signature, or other elements of the Admit Card will be treated as Unfair Means (UFM) and dealt with as per the rules.*

Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference. Admit Cards will not be sent by post or e-mail.
